3. Salutations to the noble teacher who with the collyrium-stick of knowledge has opened the eyes of the person who is blinded by the darkness of the ignorance.
4. Salutations to the noble teacher who is Brahmaa, Vishnu, Mahesh; and who is no one else but Brahman itself incarnated in human form.
5. Salutations to the noble teacher who has made it possible to know the Brahman, by whom all that is sentient and insentient, movable and immovable is pervaded.
6. Salutations to the noble teacher who showed me the One to be known, who is awareness and pervading all three worlds consisting of sentient and insentient.
